

4 AAC 04.020 is repealed and readopted to read:

4 AAC 04.020. Skills for graduating students. (a) A goal of the state public school system is to graduate students who will

- (1) possess a broad knowledge base;
- (2) communicate effectively;
- (3) use technology skills;
- (4) think logically and critically;
- (5) be healthy;
- (6) recognize, value, and use creativity;
- (7) be responsible and ethical citizens and community members; and
- (8) be enthusiastic learners.

(b) The department's publication, *World-Class Students Graduation Outcomes*, as revised as of March 19, 2009, is adopted by reference. The goals expressed in *World-Class Students Graduation Outcomes* represent goals of the state public school system.
