



LOCAL DETERMINATION LEVELS –ASSISTANCE AND ENFORCEMENT ACTIONS RUBRIC

As required by the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act (IDEA), 34 CFR section 300.600, Alaska makes an annual determination for each LEA and takes the following actions based on that determination.

Meets Requirements	District will participate in monitoring activities as scheduled.	Upon request, districts may receive technical assistance (TA) on self-identified areas of need.	None.
Needs Assistance	District will participate in monitoring activities as scheduled.	Any scheduled TA activities will include a focus on areas that impacted the district's determination. DEED will inform district of available opportunities for TA in areas of need.	If a district is determined to need assistance for two or more consecutive years, DEED will take one or more of the following actions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Advise the district of available sources of TA in the areas in which the district needs assistance; • Direct the use of IDEA funds on the area in which the district needs assistance; • Identify the district as a high-risk grantee and impose special conditions on the district's Part B grant. 34 CFR 300.604 (a)
Needs Intervention	District will participate in additional, focused, monitoring activities related to the issue(s) that resulted in the determination. This may include additional on-site monitoring, self assessments and reviews, and/or submission of additional data.	Any scheduled TA activities will include a focus on areas that impacted the district's determination. DEED will inform district of available opportunities for TA in areas of need and may require participation in specific TA activities.	If a district is determined to need intervention for three or more consecutive years, DEED will take one or more of the following actions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Require the district to prepare a corrective action or improvement plan; • Require the district to enter into a compliance agreement with DEED; • Withhold or recover Part B funds from the district; • Refer the district for further enforcement action from courts or other authorities. 34 CFR 300.604 (b)
Needs Substantial Intervention	District will participate in additional, focused, monitoring activities related to the issue(s) that resulted in the determination. This may include additional on-site monitoring, self assessments and reviews, submission of additional data, and/or an administrative evaluation of the ability of the district to implement the requirements of IDEA. The determination and results of any additional activities will be shared with general education administrators at the District and DEED.	Any scheduled TA activities will include a focus on areas that impacted the district's determination. DEED will inform district of available opportunities for TA in areas of need and may require participation in specific TA activities.	If a district is determined to need substantial intervention, or at any time DEED determines that an LEA needs substantial intervention in implementing the requirements of Part B of IDEA, or that there is substantial failure to comply with any of the conditions of the LEA's eligibility under Part B of IDEA, DEED will take one or more of the following actions: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Withhold or recover Part B funds from the district; • Refer the district for further enforcement action from courts or other authorities. 34 CFR 300.604 (c)
